


2. The cube is the cross




3. The Kerubic Cross (it's just a version of the cross that contains a lot more information that a plain cross.)




4. The cross into a cube




5. The 3D cube is a 2D hexagon (Judaism)6. The Hexagon, The Cube, and internal circles




7. . The infinite internal geometry of the hexagram

There's an old prayer take from the Kabbalah Tree of Life. (Jewish mysticism)






The next time someone tells you that an occultist is satanic, someone into magick is against the Bible,









12. The Tree of Life as it relates to the Tarot deck. The major arcana of the tarot.







13. The Tree of Life as it sits upon the body.




14. The Tree of Life as it relates to the planets and the body.





18. The Ida and Pingala as a double helix







22. The I Ching related to the embedded Trees of Life



















The symbols seem fixed and exact. 8 trigrams of the I Ching right? Yes, but there's also a unifying ninth. And the permutations of the 8 lead to 64 in balanced combinations.

10 sephiroth to the tree of life, right? Yes, but then there's also Da'ath (from which Darth Vaders name comes, trust me I know what Lucas was into.) making 11. (11)

Enneagram has nine right? Afterall ennea means nine, right? Yes but there's a tenth point in the middle, and an eleventh hidden one, the mystical 4.5. (11)

A hexagram is six points, right? Don't try to tell me it's more, you bastard! Well yes, it's six points but all those points are in relation to a center, an assumed seventh point, unstated but really the origin point that the rest is organized around.
