Talks on World Affairs Are Closed in Williamsburg

WILLIAMSBURG, Va., March 22 (AP) — Ninety-five representatives from the United States, Canada and Western Europe ended the 13th annual Bilderberg Conference on international affairs here today.

A statement issued at the closing said the topics discussed in the three-day meeting included new developments in the Soviet Union, Communist China and other Communist countries; East-West trade and political, military and economic relationships within the Atlantic alliance.

The chairman was Prince Bernhard of the Netherlands, who has served as chairman since the first parley 10 years ago at the Bilderberg Hotel in Oosterbeek, the Netherlands.
